

Alabama Watershed Operations Success Story

Northeast Yellow River Watershed Site P-11

Northeast Yellow River Site P-11 is in Covington County, Alabama (Congressional District 2). This site is part of a PL-566 Small Watersheds Project that is funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. This project consisted of the stabilization of a gully located adjacent to and endangering a 3 acre farm pond. The gully was stabilized and its drainage area diverted back into the natural drainage area of the pond. Stabilization of the gully eliminated sedimentation from the active gully and restored the gullied area to a useable condition. The farm pond was rehabilitated and brought up to current NRCS standards.

Construction on the site began in July 9, 2010, and was completed December 8, 2010, at a cost of \$217,653.
